


## WHAT IS THE 123 PLAY WITH ME WORKSHOP?

This is a free Family Place Workshop for children age 6 months to 3 years and their caregivers.

## WHAT HAPPENS AT THIS WORKSHOP?

Kids and grown-ups get to play together in a room filled with toys! While everyone is playing we will have resource professionals here to answer questions, plus handouts and information will be available to take home.

## WHAT IS COVERED IN THIS WORKSHOP?

### EARLY LITERACY

You will learn about six essential pre-reading skills that will help your child grow into a strong and successful reader. You will also learn how you can easily build those skills at home.

### SPEECH/LANGUAGE & HEARING

You will learn the milestones for communication, the signs of speech, language, and hearing issues. You will also receive information on what to do if you suspect your child may need help.

### CHILD DEVELOPMENT & PARENTING

You will learn about what to expect during the first few years, the best ways to help your children make the most of each stage of their early development, and get answers to common parenting questions.

### NUTRITION

You will get to try out fun snacks, pick up tips for getting kids to eat healthier, and take home recipes that are sure to please both kids and adults!

### PLAY & MOVEMENT

You will learn how different types of play support your child's growth! From socio-emotional development to gross and fine motor skills, you'll be an expert on all things play. We will do fun activities, play games, and give you plenty of ideas to take home.

## TIPS TO MAKE THE MOST OF YOUR VISIT:

### WEAR COMFORTABLE CLOTHES

You will be sitting on the floor playing with your child. Please wear clothes you can move around in.

### MAKE IT A FAMILY AFFAIR

If your spouse can come too, all the better. If a grandparent or other family member is playing a large part in your child's care, please invite them to join you too!

### LEAVE STROLLERS AT HOME

We do not have the space for strollers in the playroom. If you bring a stroller, it will need to be parked outside the room. We can not offer supervision of the stroller and are not responsible for any lost or damaged items while it is unattended.



## PROGRAM GUIDELINES

- Stay with your child at all times. No child can be in 123 Play With Me without their parent or adult caregiver.
- Clean up is a part of play. Please plan to stay until the end of each session to help clean up with your child by putting toys back in designated areas.
- To help everyone stay healthy, please stay home if you or your child is ill.
