Halloween Safety Tips

If your family chooses to go Trick or Treating here are some safety tips:

- 1) Look left, right and left again when crossing and keep looking as you cross.
- 2) Put electronic devices down and keep heads up and walk, don't run, across the street.
- 3) Teach children to make eye contact with drivers before crossing in front of them.
- 4) Decorate costumes and bags with reflective tape or stickers and, it possible, choose light colors.
- 5) Choose face paint and makeup whenever possible instead of masks, which can obstruct a child's vision.
- 6) Have kids carry glow sticks or flashlights to help them see and be seen by drivers.
- 7) Slow down and be especially alert in residential neighborhoods. Children are exited on Halloween and may move in unpredictable ways.
- 8) Take extra time to look for kids at intersections, on medians and the curbs.
- 9) Eliminate any distractions inside your car so you can concentrate on the road and your surroundings.
- 10) Popular trick-or-treating hours are 5:30 p.m. to 9:30 p.m. so be especially alert for kids during those hours.
