Seniors, please remember that YOU are responsible for having ACT /SAT scores sent to colleges or scholarship programs directly from the testing organization. These scores are NOT on your transcripts.

Transcripts DO include the courses you've taken in high school, the grades vou've made in those courses, your grade point average, and vour class rank. All schools and many scholarship programs will require an **OFFI-CIAL transcript from** PHS. You will need to talk with Mrs. Hardin to get an official, sealed transcript printed and mailed.

Cost is \$2 for each transcript.

The final transcript mailed in June is free.

Have you heard this?

When you turn 18, all men must register with Selective Service. By not registering you can miss out on many important opportunities like student loans, government jobs, and a driver's license in most states. You can register at any post office.

Some schools use your admissions application as the application for school-based scholarships as well.

Other schools expect you to apply for scholarships with a separate application. Call or e-mail your school of choice to make sure of their policy!

As you apply to schools, you will probably notice the regular decision deadline and an early decision deadline. Make sure that you understand the following terms:

—Early Action (Non Binding): By meeting this earlier deadline, you will receive an earlier response, but you aren't committed to attend only that school!

—Early Decision (Binding): The applicant will receive an early notification of acceptance, but *s/he is promising to attend ONLY this school if accepted*.
