Winter Weather Reminders

As cold temperatures approach us this winter season keep in mind the following reminders:

- If a 2-Hour Delay is scheduled school will start at 10 AM, and students arriving after 10 AM will be counted as tardy. Breakfast will still be available. We suggest a typical 30-minute drop-off time between 9:30 and 10:00 AM. In the event of emergency family situations, students will be able to enter the building starting at 7:30 AM.
- If a Remote Learning Day is scheduled students are responsible for completing the remote work assigned to them by their classroom teacher. Students should bring the completed work with them on the first day back to school. If students do not complete their remote work they will be counted absent for the Remote Learning Day.
- If an Early Dismissal is scheduled we ask that you communicate with the front office as soon as possible, **if your child has a change in transportation**. After School will remain open only for 3 hours after the early dismissal time. If needed, based on safety concerns, After School could potentially close earlier. Phone calls/ Remind messages will be made.
