End of Grade Testing

Testing to show all the growth and knowledge that your child has learned this year is here. Help us make sure that they are their best selves for testing by ensuring they have a good breakfast (either at home or school), get a good night's rest, and start their day off great! Our goal is to have perfect attendance on test days. Please make sure your child is here unless they are sick.

- K-2 mClass Reading Testing: Testing will be over the span of 3 weeks, but the following days are dates that the majority of testing will occur.
 - May 2nd May 5th
- 3-5 EOG Testing:
 - Science Test (5th ONLY) May 19th (If your child takes their test over two days they will test on May 22nd as well.)
 - Reading Test May 23rd (If your child takes their test over two days they will test on May 24th as well.)
 - Math Test May 25th (If your child takes their test over two days they will test on May 26th as well.)



Water Day will be held on Thursday, June 1st. We need parent volunteers to help make this day a success for our kids. There will be options to volunteer for different Water Day games, and some dry options to help make snow cones. Look out for a volunteer flyer coming home with your student soon, so you know what times they will be participating in Water Day activities.
