Dear Parent/Guardian:

The staff of Tuscola High School is pleased that your child is considering registering for AP and/or *Advanced* classes next year. For the AP (Advanced Placement) courses, the college-level work is strenuous, but the rewards for making the commitment and seeing it through are great. You may already know that a passing grade on a College Board AP exam in high school can allow a student to enter college with credit earned ahead of time. In fact, each year Tuscola has a significant number of students who enter college with various amounts of credit already earned through AP courses. To compensate for the increased difficulty of the AP and *Advanced* courses, AP classes are weighted with two extra points awarded in computing a student's Grade Point Average, while *Advanced* courses are awarded one extra point.

Please understand Tuscola's policies concerning all AP courses:

- Once students have made their final class selections, changes will **NOT** be made except in cases of administrative decisions. Thus, both students and parents should be very certain of the commitment they are making.
- All students enrolled in AP courses will be required to take the AP exams, which are administered the second two weeks of May.
- AP students will pay an **<u>\$87</u>** fee for each AP test in which they are enrolled. This fee should be paid on or before **<u>December 20, 2012</u>**.
