CRITERIA FOR ENROLLMENT:

1. For consideration for acceptance: At least a C in AP English Language and Composition, at least a B in Advanced English III, or at least an A in English III and in class completion of application assessment. Requirements stated prior, review of application assessment and overall academic performance will be looked at in composing class roster.

2. Students must have a strong desire to improve reading, speaking, critical thinking, and writing skills.

3. Students must successfully complete a summer reading program. Students will be required to read *The Lord of the Flies* and *Dress Your Family in Corduroy and Denim* or *The Tao of Pooh*. An assessment will be taken at the start of the school year.

4. Students must complete the necessary application forms.

WAYS IN WHICH CONTENT AND INSTRUCTION ARE MODIFIED FOR HIGH-ACHIEVING AND GIFTED STUDENTS:

- 1. Steady load of challenging reading: predominantly fiction, non-fiction, drama and poetry
- 2. Higher level expectations regarding study habits, initiative, commitment, and quality of work.
- 3. Advanced analysis of literature and writing assignments
