- Southwestern Community College Scholarships—Applications are available at <u>www.southwesterncc.edu/content/scholarships-scc-students</u>. Application deadlines vary.
- \$ Jagannathan Scholarship—You must apply for this scholarship by logging on to your CFNC account through <u>www.cfnc.org/jag</u>. A CSS Profile must accompany the application which must be submitted by February 16, 2012.
- \$ Best Buy Scholarships—Must be involved in community service. The application can be accessed at <u>www.bestbuy-communityrelations.com/scholarship.htm</u> and these are due by February 16, 2011.
- \$ Charles Shuford Memorial Scholarship—Emphasis is placed on 4-H, FFA, and Family & Consumer Science activities. The application and forms can be found online at <u>http://nccommunityfoundation.org</u> and the deadline is February 28, 2012.
- **\$ Nathaniel Ellis Cannady, Jr. Scholarship**—The applicants must have a minimum of 3.0 unweighted GPA, good performance on standardized tests, and class rank in the top 30%, with preference given to students with demonstrated financial need. Applications can be picked up in the Counseling Center. The deadline is **February 15, 2012**.
- \$ 2012 Student-View Scholarship Program—Simply log on to <u>www.student-view.com</u> and complete a 15-20 application survey about colleges in your area. The scholarship will be awarded via a random drawing of all completed applications. The deadline is April 22, 2012.
- **The Carrols LLC Community Scholarship Fund**—Applications are available in the Counseling Center. Applications must be completed and returned by **April 2, 2012**. Winners are chosen on merit basis and completion of application, including attached transcripts and recommendations.
