Thursday, January 28th at 6:00 P.M. (Snow Date: February 11th)

Paying your child's college bills does not have to be difficult or devastating as long as you educate yourself on financial aid.

Financial Aid Night will be held at Haywood Community College, and there will be presentations on general financial aid information, CFNC, and filling out the FAFSA.

SCHOLARSHIP INFORMATION

- **Haywood County Schools Foundation**—To be eligible, a student must be a Haywood resident, currently enrolled in a Haywood County high school, and a graduating senior. He/She must be planning to attend an approved secondary program (technical/community college, junior college, four-year institution), and have a 2.5 or better GPA. Applications are available in the Counseling Center or at <u>www.hcsf.haywood.k12.nc.us/blog/</u>. Applications are due in the Counseling Center by March 22, 2010.
- The Common Scholarship Application—Applications available at <u>www.cfwnc.org/scholarships/</u> <u>index.html</u>. All applications are due to the Counseling Center by January 15, 2010. (Includes 23 scholarships.)

Alpha Delta Kappa Scholarships—Applications are available in the Counseling Center. Deadline is February 2.

-Eunice Riggins Memorial Scholarship: Available to a female in the top 10% of the class with a minimum score of 1344 (Reading, Math, and Writing) on SAT.

-Mary Rose Mills-Linda Rankin Memorial Scholarship: Available to male or female in the top 10% of class with a minimum SAT score of 1488 (Reading, Math, Writing).

-Student Achievement Scholarship: Available to male or female with an SAT score between 1344-1560 (Reading, Math, Writing) and a GPA between 2.5 and 3.5. (Applications are available at <u>www.nccommunityfoundation.org</u>.) -Clare Johnson Marley-Mary Earle Berger Fine Arts Scholarship: Open to any student ranked in the top 20% of class with a minimum SAT score of 1344 (Reading, Math, Writing), and proof of abilities/talents in the area of fine arts.

New scholarship information is available in the Counseling Center. Students make sure you check the college websites for scholarships specific to that school. There may be separate applications required!!!

FAFSA Day!

On Saturday, February 13, 2010 college financial aid officers and other financial aid specialists will assist students in the completion and the electronic submission of their Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) forms.

IMPORTANT NOTES:

1) FAFSA Day takes place before most deadlines for submission of the form, but you should check with the institutions you are considering to make sure their deadlines are not earlier. If the deadlines are earlier, you should not wait for the FAFSA Day program to submit your application.

2) While the intention of this program is to provide assistance in completing the FAFSA, some colleges require additional documents, such as institutional financial aid forms or the CSS PROFILE. The financial aid representatives on site the day of the program will try to answer questions or provide general information you might have about forms other than the FAFSA, or will advise you if the North Carolina institutions you are considering require additional forms; however they may not be familiar with some forms. In such instances they will advise students to contact the financial aid offices at the colleges they are considering, if they need assistance.
