Attendance and Tardy Policy

Students must be in class and on time for the entire duration of class, PARTICIPATE, and attempt all assignments in order to be successful. The school attendance policy will be followed.

- Absences 7-9 Must make up time
- 10 Absences = Make up time and Appeal for Credit
- Tardies-all students that are not in the classroom with ALL THEIR REQUIRED SUPPLIES by the bell must report to the ISS room and return with a tardy slip.
- If a student needs to check out a chrome book, they must return with a tardy slip.
- If a student is not present in class for at least half the class period, then it is an automatic absence.

If you are absence for any reason, it is your responsibility to see me for missed notes and CHECK GOOGLE CLASSROOM. You can request a video to watch to make up the missed lesson.

Participation/Assignments

Students are expected to work on warm-ups, take notes, complete assignments and ask/answer questions and keep their notebook organized. Warm-Ups, notes and other assignments will be checked in a variety of forms and graded on a regular basis.

Late Work/Make Up Work/Class Work/Assessments

No late work will be accepted unless you are absent from class or there are extenuating circumstances that has been approved by the teacher and on a case by case basis. The school policy will be followed for makeup work. Any missed test or quiz due to an absence must be made up outside of class instruction time and within 1 week of the given assessment. A ZERO will be issued and only replaced when the assessment is completed within the time frame. All ASSESSMENTS must be completed within the time allotted and with the Teacher. Students ARE NOT allowed to complete assessments outside of class time unless discussed prior.

Homework/Online Assignments

Homework and online assignments will be assigned daily. Most assignments will be reviewed in class the following day. The student must bring/submit the completed assignment **WITH APPROPRIATE WORK SHOWN** to class/online in order to receive credit. Homework will be due the following morning unless told otherwise.

Classroom Management Plan

All students are expected to behave appropriately both online and in class in order to allow teaching and learning to occur. Classroom Rules:

ACT with INTEGRITY!

b. Do NOT DO ANYTHING THAT DISRUPTS the learning of OTHERS which includes the following but is not limited to:

- o No Profanity
- Stay in your seat at all times unless given permission.
- No throwing objects of any kind in the room.
- c. The teacher, not the bell, dismisses class.

d. Absolutely **No Cell phones/Earbuds/Electronic Devices** (automatic referral see syllabus)

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e. CHROME BOOK Usage is for learning purposes only. If you are using your chromebook for any other purpose and are on the chromebook when you are not allowed, an automatic referral will be written for MISUSE OF TECHNOLOGY.

e. ONLY WATER is allowed in this class!!!

2. Be where you are supposed to be when you are supposed to be there.

a. Be in your seat working on the warm up with all your materials out on your desk when the bell rings.

b. Attend to personal needs BEFORE class. This includes going to the restroom, water fountain, other classes, and sharpening your pencil.

3. Be prepared to learn and to teach.

a. Be prepared when you arrive to class with **ALL MATERIALS** (notebook, chromebook, and pencil) and a good attitude.

b. No Sleeping or head on desk during class
