*Final Exam: 25% of your final grade

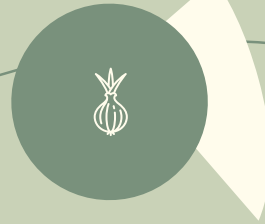
Grading Process:

All graded work will be returned every Monday, & students will receive an individual conference on their academic & attendance standing.

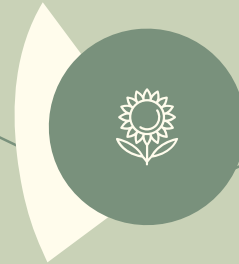


What?

You will have to make up time at the end of the semester. Sessions are \$3. You must make up time for each class that you go over 6 absences in.


