

## DECEMBER SCHOLARSHIP INFORMATION

(Please check with colleges regarding scholarships to ensure deadlines are met! This is not a complete list but scholarships that we are aware of at this time.)

Check out the school you are interested in on their website for additional scholarships!

- **NAVY ROTC Scholarships**—Please let your counselor know if you are interested in a Navy ROTC Scholarship so that we can set up a meeting with our local recruiter. The typical SAT score needed is 1150 for combined Critical Reading and Math or a ACT composite score of 24.
- Air Force ROTC Scholarships—Please let your counselor know if you are interested so that we can set up a meeting with our local recruiter. The criteria includes SAT score of 1180 (Math & Critical reading only), ACT Composite of 26, and a GPA of 3.0.
- Serea College Scholarships—Berea awards a 4-year, tuition scholarship to every admitted student. This scholarship works in conjunction with any other grants or scholarships students receive to completely cover the cost of tuition. If you are interested in attending Berea College—please see your counselor!!!
- **\$** Lenoir-Rhyne University Teaching Scholars— Can provide up to \$5,500 per year for four years. Learn more about this program and apply at EDU.LR.EDU/TEACHINGSCHOLARS by January 10th, 2016.
- **\$** Meredith College-Download talent scholarship applications at Meredith.edu/admissions deadline is January 15th.
- \$ Students that are interested in a Trade School such as Universal Technical Institute, NASCAR Technical Institute, Marine Mechanics Institute, and Motorcycle Mechanics Institute may visit UTI.edu/scholarships
- \$ CFWNC Scholarships- These scholarships and their materials are now on the CFWNC website. There are several scholarships available including Chuck D. Hargrove Scholarship (THS students only), Nathaniel Ellis Cannady, Jr. Scholarship, WNC Regional Scholarships, and several more. This is one application that you

complete to be eligible for several scholarships. The Counseling Center will mail all applications together. Tuscola students do very well with these scholarships!

- Ione M. Allen Music Scholarship—Applicants must demonstrate academic achievement and financial need, demonstrate traits of high personal character and leadership, demonstrate a musical aptitude, and must major in Music and be planning to attend a musical conservatory or other educational institution. Semi-Finalist will be interviewed by the Awards Advisory Committee, and will present a 5-minute musical performance. Deadline is January 11, 2016. Apply on-line at www.csascholars.org.
- \$ Mensa Education and Research Foundation Scholarships—The <u>only eligibility requirements</u> are that the applicant be enrolled, for the academic year following the award, in a degree program in an accredited American institute of post-secondary education, and be a resident of the area of a participating local group of American Mensa. For the general awards, the applicant need <u>not</u> be a member of Mensa nor qualified for Mensa, and the general awards are unrestricted as to age, race, gender, level of post-secondary education and financial need. - \$ Area 1 North Carolina Soil and Water Conservation District Conservation Scholarship Application—High school students interested in pursuing a college major in the studies of agriculture, field science, conservation, energy, natural resources, environmental science or related field are encouraged to apply. Applications are available in the Counseling Center and must be submitted to the address provided by February 1st, 2016.
- **\$** Ronald McDonald House Charities Scholarship Program—There are four different scholarships to apply for so please review information to see which scholarships you may be eligible for at <u>https://aim.applyists.net/RMHC</u>. We have had a Tuscola student win in the past so please apply! The application deadline is January 20, 2016.
- \$ Alpha Delta Kappa Scholarships—Scholarship applications are available in the Counseling Center and are due back to the Counseling Center on January 15, 2016 so that we can turn in applications to local chapter by the deadline. There are 3 separate scholarships to apply for!

- Foundation for Sight & Sound Scholarships for Disabled Students— for students who are blind, deaf/hard of hearing and/or visually impaired. Go to: http://www.foundationforsightandsound.org/scholarship.php and deadline is March 27th, 2016.
- \$ 2016 American Meteorological Society Freshmen Undergraduate Scholarship Program—This scholarship is for students who intend to pursue careers in the atmospheric or related oceanic and hydrologic sciences. Applications and more information is available in the Counseling Center. The applications must be postmarked by February 5th, 2016.
- \$ NC Motherless Daughters Scholarship—The scholarship is open to NC young women who have had the unfortunate loss of their mother. There are two scholarships available for high school seniors. - \$ Kings College Scholarship Day—King's College will hold their College Scholarship Event on Saturday– January 23, 2016. Students should arrive at 10am—no pre-registration is needed. They will award scholarships based on the scholarship exam that students will take that day.
