

NOVEMBER SCHOLARSHIP INFORMATION



Please check with each college you are interested in regarding scholarships to ensure deadlines are met!

This is not a complete list but scholarships that we are aware of at this time.

- \$ **NAVY ROTC Scholarships**—Please let your counselor know if you are interested in a Navy ROTC Scholarship so that we can set up a meeting with our local recruiter. The typical SAT score needed is 1150 for combined Critical Reading and Math or a ACT composite score of 24.
- \$ **Berea College Scholarships**—Berea awards a 4-year, tuition scholarship to every admitted student. This scholarship works in conjunction with any other grants or scholarships students receive to completely cover the cost of tuition. ***If you are interested in attending Berea College—please see your counselor so we can nominate you for scholarships!!!***
- \$ **StudentScholarships.org**—Search various scholarships such as:

- \$ **East Tennessee State University Scholarships for Border County Residents**—The Presidential, Provost, Deans and Faculty Scholarships are all based on GPA and Test Scores. - \$ **NCSU College of Textile Scholarships**—Various other scholarships for the College of Textiles at NCSU can be found at go.ncsu.edu/cotscholarships. Application deadline is **December 1, 2017**.
- \$ **CFWNC Scholarships**— These scholarships and their materials are now on the CFWNC website. There are several scholarships available including Chuck D. - \$ **Ione M. Allen Music Scholarship**—Applicants must demonstrate academic achievement and financial need, demonstrate traits of high personal character and leadership, demonstrate a musical aptitude, and must major in Music and be planning to attend a musical conservatory or other educational institution. Semi-Finalist will be interviewed by the Awards Advisory Committee, and will present a 5-minute musical performance. Deadline is **January 2, 2017**. Apply on-line at www.csascholars.org.
- \$ **Clemson University Lyceum Scholars Program**—Lyceum Scholars study the moral, political, and economics foundations of a free society. A unique curriculum and faculty mentor set this scholarship apart! Students need to apply at www.clemson.edu/capitalism/lyceum.html.
- \$ **TWS Jacksonville Scholarships**— Several Welding Scholarships are available and more information is available in the Counseling Center.
- \$ **The Citadel Military College**—Any minority student interested in The Citadel must see your counselor for more information regarding scholarship opportunities.

- \$ **Cheatham-White Scholarship at NCA&T** (North Carolina Agricultural and Technical State University)—Interested students should visit www.ncat.edu/academics/honors/cheatham-white for more information.

- \$ **Miss North Carolina Jr. High/High School/Collegiate Pageant**—The pageant competition does not include a swimsuit or talent competition. There are numerous prizes and scholarship opportunities. To learn more visit www.missnorthcarolinahighschool.webs.com.
- \$ **Mensa Education and Research Foundation Scholarships**—The only eligibility requirements are that the applicant be enrolled, for the academic year following the award, in a degree program in an accredited American institute of post-secondary education, and be a resident of the area of a participating local group of American Mensa. For the general awards, the applicant need not be a member of Mensa nor qualified for Mensa, and the general awards are unrestricted as to age, race, gender, level of post-secondary education and financial need. - \$ **ACT Student Champion Award**—The ACT Student Champion Award recognizes one student in each state who is tenacious and persistent, no matter the challenge, and is prepared for life after high school with a goal in mind and plan in place. ACT Student Champions receive a \$500 non-renewable scholarship, certificate, plaque, and state-level recognition. Students in the graduating class of 2018 who have taken the ACT who fit the following criteria are encouraged to apply:
 - *A student who has overcome challenges and can articulate education and career actions
 - *Students must have a composite ACT score of a 22 on a single test date or a 3.0 or greater on a 4.0 scale
 - *Preference will be given to underrepresented and/or first-generation college students.
 Applications can be found at www.act.org/readinesschampions. Applications are **due December 31, 2017**, and champions will be **notified on or before April 2, 2018**. If applicants are under the age of 18, they must complete [this form](#) in addition to the application.
- \$ **B. Davis Scholarship**—The creators of the “Student Award Search Aid website are offering a scholarship. Please visit our website at <http://www.studentawardsearch.com/scholarships.htm> to read about us and apply for the scholarship. While you are there, browse through other scholarships. This site is free and application deadline is **May 22, 2018**.
- \$ **The University of Alabama**—Entering freshmen must submit the following by **December 15** of their senior year in high school to be considered for academic scholarships: [Application for admission](#) & [Application for scholarships](#), official high school transcript, official test score on either the ACT or SAT, required scholarship documentation (if applicable). The scholarship deadline is **December 15** (the scholarship application should be submitted online by December 15 and any required materials sent by mail should be postmarked no later than December 15). This means that the national December ACT and national December SAT results are the last college entrance examination results accepted for students who wish to be considered for scholarships.
- \$ **Montreat College**—WNC Scholarship Program at Montreat provides eligible students in Haywood County an opportunity to apply. Students must have a 3.0 GPA and 1000 combined Critical Reading and Math score on SAT or 21 Composite ACT score. Apply for Admission by **January 1, 2018**. - \$ **National Co-Op Scholarship Program**—There is a book available in the Counseling Center to review if you are interested in these scholarships!

\$ The University of North Georgia Military Scholarships—Seniors who want a full time professional career after college, but also want to serve part-time in the Georgia Army National Guard should apply. The University of North Georgia Military Scholarship (UNGMS) is an excellent pathway. It pays nearly all college expenses, and recipients actually make \$30,000 - \$40,000 over four years more than the cost to attend. There are 42 scholarships available per year.

Benefits:

- Pays for tuition, fees, room, meals, books, and uniforms = \$70,000+ over four years
- Learn a skill taught by the Army
- Learn practical leadership skills in demand by employers
- Receive pay for Army basic training and job-specific training; monthly Montgomery GI Bill; monthly and annual drill pay = \$30,000+ over four years
