

OCTOBER SCHOLARSHIP INFORMATION



Please check with each college you are interested in regarding scholarships to ensure deadlines are met!

This is not a complete list but scholarships that we are aware of at this time.

- \$ **Marsha K. Prestage Agricultural Scholarship** requires that CALS students who are applying for freshman admission for Fall 2018 within production Ag majors (*Agricultural Business Management, Agricultural Education, Agricultural & Environmental Technology, Animal Science - NOT pre-vet intent, Biological & Agricultural Engineering, Extension Education & Poultry Science*) **submit an application for admission by October 15, 2017**. Eligible students from applicable majors will be invited to apply for this unique scholarship which will cover the cost of tuition, books, and fees for up to four years. - \$ **NAVY ROTC Scholarships**—Please let your counselor know if you are interested in a Navy ROTC Scholarship so that we can set up a meeting with our local recruiter. The typical SAT score needed is 1150 for combined Critical Reading and Math or a ACT composite score of 24.
- \$ **Berea College Scholarships**—Berea awards a 4-year, tuition scholarship to every admitted student. This scholarship works in conjunction with any other grants or scholarships students receive to completely cover the cost of tuition. ***If you are interested in attending Berea College—please see your counselor so we can nominate you for scholarships!!!***
- \$ **StudentScholarships.org**—Search various scholarships such as:
Dr. Pepper Tuition Giveaway Scholarship, VIP Voice Scholarships, Student Photography Scholarship, National Space Club Scholarship AND more.....
- \$ **East Tennessee State University Scholarships for Border County Residents**—The Presidential, Provost, Deans and Faculty Scholarships are all based on GPA and Test Scores. - \$ **Centennial Scholarship at NCSU**—This scholarship is for students interested in the College of Textiles at NCSU. IF interested, please let your counselor know by **October 31, 2017** so that we can nominate students OR you can self-nominate.
- \$ **NCSU College of Textile Scholarships**—Various other scholarships for the College of Textiles at NCSU can be found at go.ncsu.edu/cotscholarships. Application deadline is **December 1, 2017**.
- \$ **Cooke Scholars Program**—The Jack Kent Cooke Foundation College Scholarship Program is an undergraduate scholarship program available to high-achieving high school seniors with financial need who seek to attend and graduate from the nation's best four-year colleges and universities. Selected from a nationwide pool of applicants, up to 40 students will become Jack Kent Cooke Scholars and have access to funding for up to four years for undergraduate studies. Each award is intended to cover a significant share of the student's educational expenses – including tuition, living expenses, books and required fees. Awards vary by individual, based on the cost of tuition as well as other grants or scholarships he or she may receive. - \$ Roanoke College Scholars Program**—To be considered for these scholarships, you must complete the Scholarship Competition application and be a prospective college freshman seeking first-time fall enrollment. You must also be accepted to the College prior to the competition. Students with at least a 3.2 cumulative grade point average in a rigorous academic curriculum should consider applying for the Scholarship Competition. - \$ Danforth Scholarship at Washington University in St. Louis**—To be eligible for this scholarship, students must let their Counselor know! There is a sign-up sheet in the Counseling Center and students must be nominated by their counselor. We need to know of your interest by **November 1st, 2017**.
- \$ The Prudential Spirit of Community Awards**—If you've made a difference by volunteering in your community over the past year, you could win \$1,000 and a fabulous trip to Washington, D.C., by applying for a Prudential Spirit of Community Award! Even more importantly, you could win recognition that might inspire other young people to follow your example. These prestigious awards, sponsored by Prudential Financial and the National Association of Secondary School Principals, have honored tens of thousands of middle level and high school students over the past 18 years solely for their volunteer work. - \$ Goodnight Scholarship at NCSU**—Students wishing to be considered for this scholarship must apply to NCSU by **October 15th**. More info is available at <http://goodnight.ncsu.edu> Students must be a North Carolina resident, have an adjusted gross income up to \$100,000 and demonstrate financial need, select a [STEM \(Science, Technology, Engineering or Math\) major or STEM education major](#), demonstrate a history of exceptional academic performance. The dynamic type of student selected to apply typically achieves the following: *Rank in the top 2% of his/her graduating class, score above 1450 on the new SAT (CR+M) (equivalent to a 1400 on the old SAT) and/or score above a 32 on the ACT, and have at least a 3.9 (unweighted) GPA and/or 4.8 (weighted) GPA.*
- \$ Coca-Cola Scholars Foundation**—The online application is available at www.coca-colascholars.org and the deadline to complete is **October 31, 2017**. You will have to create a username & password to begin the application.
- \$ Cheatham-White Scholarship at NCA&T** (North Carolina Agricultural and Technical State University)—Interested students should visit www.ncat.edu/academics/honors/cheatham-white for more information.
- \$ North Carolina High School Athletic Association Scholarships**— There are numerous scholarships available through this association for North Carolina students. Scholarships and more information is available at <http://www.nchsaa.org/students-parents/nchsaa-endowed-fund-scholarships>
- \$ Miss North Carolina Jr. High/High School/Collegiate Pageant**—The pageant competition does not include a swimsuit or talent competition. There are numerous prizes and scholarship opportunities. To learn more visit www.missnorthcarolinahighschool.webs.com.
- \$ Mensa Education and Research Foundation Scholarships**—The only eligibility requirements are that the applicant be enrolled, for the academic year following the award, in a degree program in an accredited American institute of post-secondary education, and be a resident of the area of a participating local group of American Mensa. For the general awards, the applicant need not be a member of Mensa nor qualified for Mensa, and the general awards are unrestricted as to age, race, gender, level of post-secondary education and financial need. - \$ Appalachian State University Scholarships**— Complete your application for admission prior to the **November 15** deadline with application for Admission, Official High School Transcript, Official Test Score(s): we accept both SAT and/or ACT, and Application Fee or Fee Waiver. Then complete your application for [Merit Scholarship and Selective Academic Programs](#) by November 15 with two letters of recommendation, resume, and three individual essays (prompts are provided in the application). Watch your email and your [MyApp](#) account for more information. Select scholarship applicants will be invited to visit campus and interview for potential scholarship awards during Scholars Day. This invitation-only event is held each February.
- \$ Clemson University Lyceum Scholars Program**—Lyceum Scholars study the moral, political, and economics foundations of a free society. A unique curriculum and faculty mentor set this scholarship apart! Students need to apply at www.clemson.edu/capitalism/lyceum.html.
- \$ Robertson Scholars Leadership Program**—The Scholarship Program provides scholarships to students attending Duke University & The University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill. The online application is available at www.robertsonscholars.org and the deadline to apply is **November 15**. Once registered, you can use your username and password to access your application at any time. Please remember, your application to the Robertson Scholars Leadership Program is supplemental to your application to Duke University or the University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill. You must also apply for admission to Duke and/or UNC-Chapel Hill by the respective Regular Decision deadline(s).
- \$ Montreat College**—WNC Scholarship Program at Montreat provides eligible students in Haywood County an opportunity to apply. Students must have a 3.0 GPA and 1000 combined Critical Reading and Math score on SAT or 21 Composite ACT score. Apply for Admission by **January 1, 2018**. - \$ National Co-Op Scholarship Program**—There is a book available in the Counseling Center to review if you are interested in these scholarships!
- \$ TWS Jacksonville Scholarships**— Several Welding Scholarships are available and more information is available in the Counseling Center.
- \$ The Citadel Military College**—Any minority student interested in The Citadel must see your counselor for more information regarding scholarship opportunities.
- \$ SunTrust Off To College Scholarship Sweepstakes**—Two winners randomly chosen every two weeks from October 31st—to May 15th. Students can enter at www.suntrusteducation.com/scholarshipsweepstakes
- \$ The University of Alabama**—Entering freshmen must submit the following by **December 15** of their senior year in high school to be considered for academic scholarships: [Application for admission](#) & [Application for scholarships](#), official high school transcript, official test score on either the ACT or SAT, required scholarship documentation (if applicable). The scholarship deadline is **December 15** (the scholarship application should be submitted online by December 15 and any required materials sent by mail should be postmarked no later than December 15). This means that the national December ACT and national December SAT results are the last college entrance examination results accepted for students who wish to be considered for scholarships.
- \$ QuestBridge-National College Match**—This is a service for High School Seniors who have Academic Achievement as well as Financial Need! A household income of less than \$60,000 for a typical family of four, with limited assets may be considered. Scholarship assistance is part of the program to make certain colleges more affordable!

\$ The Shelton National Leadership Scholarship - This is a four-year leadership scholarship/stipend total package in the amount of \$40,000 tuition plus \$6,000 leadership enrichment stipend to support their college experience, if they choose to attend NC State University. The scholarship is awarded to an entering freshman, valued at \$10,000 per year, renewable upon satisfactory academic progress and leadership involvement at NC State. The scholarship is open to rising/current seniors who are in the process of applying for college in the fall semester of their senior year in high school. The application process is currently open and available for students to submit their application through **October 15, 2017**. More information is available at <https://sheltonleadership.ncsu.edu>.

\$ Thomas Wolfe Scholarship at UNC Chapel Hill -The Thomas Wolfe Scholarship will accept applications beginning September 1st, 2017. **Please note that our application process involves two separate steps and two different dates, and all applicants must take both steps and meet both deadlines, to be eligible:** 1) Thomas Wolfe Scholarship applicants must apply to the University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill by the University's October 15th, 2017. EARLY admission deadline and must meet all academic requirements for EARLY admission; and 2) Scholarship applicants must also apply to The Thomas Wolfe Scholarship, with the deadline for submissions to the Scholarship being November 15th, 2017 (submissions must be postmarked by that date). *These are two distinct application processes and require different forms and separate mailings.* The application is available at <http://englishcomplit.unc.edu/creative/scholarship/tws>.
