AP EXAMS WILL TAKE PLACE MAY 2nd - MAY 13th. In order to provide the best testing environment possible, all **exams will be given off-site** and **students must arrange their own transportation**. Exams will last approximately 4 hours, and students will not be dismissed until the exam has officially ended (no students will be dismissed early).

ITEMS TO BRING TO THE EXAM ROOM:

- Several sharpened **#2 Pencils** (with erasers) for completing multiple choice answer sheets.
- **Black or Dark-Blue pen** for completing areas on the exam booklet covers and for free-response questions in most exams.
- Up to two **AP-APPROVED GRAPHING CALCULATORS**, if you are taking the Calculus AB or Statistics exam. *Be sure batteries work. Extra batteries will NOT be available at the testing site. See the attached list of "AP-APPROVED GRAPHING CALCULATORS."*
- If applicable, your **College Board SSD Student Accommodation Letter**, which verifies that you have been approved for any testing accommodations.
- Your **Social Security Number** for identification purposes. This is optional. If you provide it, your SS number will appear on all AP score reports. *Some colleges and universities use Social Security numbers as student identifiers when assigning AP credit or advanced placement for qualifying AP scores. While the College Board does not require students to provide their Social Security number, they may want to check with the colleges or universities where they are sending scores to see if they want students to provide a Social Security number on their AP Exam answer sheet.*

ITEMS NOT ALLOWED IN THE EXAM ROOM:

- Electronic Devices (cell phone, smartphone, smartwatch, laptop, tablet computer, etc.), portable listening or recording devices (MP3 player, iPod, etc.), cameras or other photographic equipment, devices that can access the Internet, and any other electronic or communication devices.
- Books, compasses, mechanical pencils, correction fluid, dictionaries, highlighters, notes, or colored pencils.
- Rulers, straightedges, or protractors.
- Scratch paper (*notes can be made on portions of the exam booklets*).
- Watches that beep or have an alarm, or smartwatches.
- Food or drink* (*except as noted below*).
- Clothing with subject-related information .

OTHER REMINDERS:

- Dress in layers or bring a sweater or sweatshirt
- *You may bring a snack and drink to the exam site for the 10-minute break between sections of the exam.
- You are required to abide by the policies of the College Board AND Tuscola High School during the exam period. Any misconduct will be reported and could jeopardize your AP Exam score.
- You are not required to attend school on the day of your AP Exam(s). Students will be considered Code 6.


