ITEMS TO BRING TO TESTING:

- Several sharpened #2 Pencils with erasers for completing multiple choice answer sheets
- Black or Dark-Blue pen for completing areas on exam booklet covers and free-response questions in most exams
- An AP authorized calculator (up to two) if you are taking AP Calculus or Statistics (Make sure the batteries work, extras will not be provided). Visit <u>www.collegeboard.com/ap/calculators</u> for a list of authorized calculators.
- If applicable, your SSD Student Accommodation Letter, which verifies that you have been approved for extended time or another testing accommodation.
- Your Social Security Number for identification purposes (optional). If you provide it, the number will appear on your AP score reports. Some colleges and universities use Social Security numbers as student identifiers when assigning AP credit or advanced placement for qualifying AP scores. While the College Board does not require students to provide their Social Security number, they may want to check with the college or university where they are sending scores to see if they prefer for students provide a Social Security number on their AP Exam answer sheet.

ITEMS NOT ALLOWED IN THE EXAM ROOM:

- Electronic Devices (cell phone, smart phone, laptop, tablet computer, etc.), portable listening or recording devices (MP3 player, iPod, etc.), cameras or other photographic equipment, devices that can access the Internet, and any other electronic or communication devices.
- Unapproved aids: books, compasses, mechanical pencils, correction fluid, dictionaries, highlighters, notes or colored pencils
- Rulers, straightedges, or protractors
- Scratch paper
- Reference Guides, keyboard maps, or other typing instructions
- Watches that beep or have an alarm, or smartwatches
- Clothing with subject-related information
- Food or drink

OTHER REMINDERS:

- Dress in layers or bring a sweater or sweatshirt
- You may bring a snack and drink to the exam site for the 10-minute break, but you may not have it in the exam room
- You are required to abide by the policies of the College Board AND Tuscola High School during the exam period. Any misconduct will be reported and could jeopardize your AP Exam score.
- You are not required to attend school on the day of your AP Exam(s). Students will be considered Code 6.

DIRECTIONS TO THE REGIONAL HIGH TECH CENTER (from THS):

- Turn left onto Liner Cove Rd.
- Go to the 2nd stoplight (just past Terminix) and turn right onto Industrial Park Road
- The High Tech Center is the brick building on the right

DIRECTIONS TO THE HAZELWOOD CONFERENCE CENTER (from THS):

- Turn right onto Liner Cove Rd
- Turn left onto access road to get on the bypass
- Take Exit 98 (Walmart Exit) and go 2nd stoplight.
- Take a left onto South Main Street
- At the 4th stoplight, turn left onto Virginia Ave. (Parking in front of building or behind)

DIRECTIONS TO THE EDUCATION CENTER IN CLYDE (from THS):

- At stoplight at the bottom of Tuscola School Rd, turn right.
- Stay straight through the stoplight and proceed to the stop sign.
- Turn left and proceed to next stop sign, turn right
- At stoplight, turn left and proceed to stop sign, turn right.
- Education Center will be on the left.
