Students must apply for scholarships that they are eligible for so please check necessary requirements. Only the first page of the FAFSA form is needed, not the entire document. Students applying for HCSF, Champion Credit Union and the Reuben Robertson Scholarships, only need to fill out one application. They will just need to complete the separate essays as required. Students must submit completed applications to the Counseling Center no later than Monday—March 12, 2018.

- **\$ 2018-2019 Golden Leaf Scholarship**—There are several requirements for the scholarship and the application is available at CFNC.org/goldenleaf. The application deadline is March 1, 2018.
