

AP EXAM INFORMATION

- ⇒ You should arrive 20-25 minutes before the exam is scheduled to begin.
- ⇒ Exams are scheduled to last approximately 4 hours.
- ⇒ Dress in layers and wear comfortable clothing. It can be very cold at some locations so it's suggested that you bring a jacket and socks to be comfortable!
- ⇒ All exams will be given at the High Tech Center, HCC, and Tuscola Media Center






What To Bring:






- Several sharpened No.2 pencils (with erasers) for all multiple choice answer sheets.
You may not use mechanical pencils for AP tests or other College Board Exams!
- Black or dark-blue ballpoint pens for free response questions in most exams.
- Your social security number for identification purposes on your answer sheet.
- Snack and/or water for break!

What Not To Bring:

- Books, compasses, correction fluid, dictionaries, highlighters, or notes.
- Watches that beep or alarm.
- Portable listening devices—even with headphones.
- All electronic devices. An authorized calculator will be provided on site.
