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## **Course Description**

The music classroom offers a place for creativity, physical activity, camaraderie, and intellect throughout the school day. Concert choir is a space for all singers to grow as musicians and learners.

# **Student Learning Objectives**

Students will...

- Perform standard and contemporary choral repertoire
- Develop aural skills (using your ear to identify pitches, intervals, and other musical elements)
- Develop sight-reading ability (ability to read and sing music on the spot without hearing it first)
- Develop vocal technique
- Learn basic music theory and history
- Understand the cultural significance of a variety of repertoire

# **Performance and Rehearsal Dates**

\*\*\*Theater/ Choral Boosters are responsible for concessions at all JV/Varsity football games this semester. Each family is responsible for a minimum of 1 game, and including 4 additional adults and 7 students. You may invite anyone you wish to join you- they do not have to be associated with THS. Dates and schedules will be given out at our first Booster meeting. ### **Concert Attire**

Students should dress formally for all performances, wearing white tops, black bottoms, and flat black shoes of their choice. Clothing choices should be school-appropriate, with shoulders covered and dresses/skirts at or below the knee. If you need help acquiring concert attire, please let us know at least one month before the performance date.

### **Class Material**

Students will interact with a variety of material this semester. In addition to our music repertoire, we will explore text connected to the music (in direct-source cases). We will also read excerpts from the following books:

### **Inclusion Statement**

In the choral community, *all* students will be treated with kindness and respect. Any infractions to this policy will result in disciplinary action, no exceptions. Please see class expectations below.

#### **Classroom Expectations:**

- Students will arrive to class prepared with required materials.
- Students will be seated and ready to warm up promptly at the start of class.
- Students will treat each other and the instructor with kindness and respect as established in our opening class discussions.
- Students will be respectful of rehearsal and instructional time by avoiding excessive chatter.
- Students will not be permitted to use cell phones during class time. Please communicate with instructors in cases of extenuating circumstances.

#### \*Restroom Policy:

Students will sign out to use the restroom and sign back in upon arrival. If a student is signed out for a total of more than 30 minutes in a week, they will need to make up 20 minutes of that time in lunch detention.

#### \*Cell Phone Policy:

Cell phones will not be allowed in the classroom. If parents have an emergency or the student has extenuating circumstances the parent/ student will utilize the phone in the main office. This is a campus wide policy. 1st offense is a warning, followed by office referrals.

#### **Disciplinary Action:**

1st offense: verbal warning 2nd offense: 20-minute detention before/after school or during lunch. Students will work in the choral library or work on a supplemental assignment during this time 3rd offense: call home 4th offense: office referral

\*\*At any point, Mrs. Yates may call home or make an office referral pending the behavior.

### Communication
