























SHIRTS With shirts, the card must cover any exposed skin between the shirt and the collarbone. The straps of tank tops must be as wide as the length of the card. When layering tops, one single strap must meet the card requirement. Tank Tops & Muscle tops must cover underarms and side of chest areas. Shirts may not be strapless, or have any open back (partial or whole). SHORTS For shorts, place a card vertically from the bottom of the shorts. The other end of the card must reach the top of the knee using the card. No skin above the knee should be showing when using the card. Shorts must be worn at the waist and cannot show undergarments. No holes are allowed above the knee. Bermuda shorts or Capri's are recommended.	 Card is to be used in this direction; only one card length of skin should be exposed between the knee and the bottom of the shorts. Bermuda shorts are recommended.

PANTS Pants are to be worn at the waist and cannot show undergarments. Capri pants are acceptable. For pants, holes above the knee must meet the card test. Place a card vertically at the top of the knee. Holes are only permitted in the card length area. No holes are permitted above the card. Leggings are permitted, but the buttock area must be completely covered by a shirt.	 			
SKIRTS/DRESSES Must pass same test as shorts. Exposed skin above the knee may only be one vertical card length. Leggings or shorts may be worn underneath skirts or dresses as a personal preference. Wearing leggings or shorts under a skirt/dress DOES NOT exempt the skirt/dress from the card length test.	 Card is to be used in this direction; only one card length of skin should be exposed 			

STUDENT APPEARANCE

WMS regulations require a student to attend school in "appropriate" dress.

Please review the information below as well as the dress code images and guide lines on page 14.

- ID card, driver's license, or debit cards are examples of cards that can be used to self-check for the "card" test in order to determine if clothing is long enough for school.
- Shoes must be worn at all times.
- Students may wear leggings (tights are not considered leggings). If leggings are worn, the buttock area must be completely covered by a shirt.
- Pants / Shorts should not have chains or other attachments.
- Pajamas and bedroom slippers are not to be worn.
- Clothing should completely cover all undergarments
- Students will only be permitted to wear headgear (hats, toboggans, hoodies, etc...) outside of school buildings.
- Bandannas are not permitted at any time.
- Clothing cannot have logos or symbols which refer to or promote tobacco, drugs, alcohol, violence, gangs, lewd conduct, or anything of an offensive nature.
- Presenting a bodily appearance or wearing clothing which is disruptive, provocative, revealing, profane, vulgar, offensive, or obscene, or which endangers the health or safety of the student or others, is prohibited.

If a child is not in compliance with the dress code, a parent will be notified to bring their

child appropriate clothing. If the parent is unable to be reached, the child will be placed in ISS for the remainder of the day or provided with acceptable attire, when available.

This document should not be regarded as the full and final set of WMS dress code regulations. The WMs administration reserves the right to make assessments on individual dress code incidents as the need arises, and the WMS administration reserves the right to revise these regulations at any time if they deem it necessary.
