The goal of the Haywood Early College (HEC) admissions process is to select and admit a diverse group of students who have a genuine interest in the pursuit of this unique and rigorous program. The selected student population will closely reflect the diversity of Haywood County. Before completing the application, review the following information. If you have any questions, please call us at 565.4000.

Is HEC the right place for you?

- Students commit to completing a high school diploma and a college transfer associate degree.
- All high school classes are taught as honors level courses.
- Students begin college transfer courses in the ninth grade.
- Students often work in teams on projects and presentations.
- Students participate in off-campus learning activities; participation is required.
- Students commit to excellent attendance and arriving to school on time.
- College courses require the same expectations, content, and levels of rigor for HEC students as for traditional college students.
- · College courses have no excused absences. Once absences exceed the mandated number, students are dropped from the college course and do not receive credit for the course.
- Cost of college textbooks is covered by Haywood Early College.
- Students are not eligible to participate in their district high school athletic programs, band, chorus, or ROTC programs.
- Students failing to meet standards for academic progress at HEC and/or HCC will be considered for an alternative pathway for graduation.

Commitment Statement: We understand and accept the above information as it may apply to our son or daughter. We understand that Haywood Early College requires a substantial commitment and that signing this document is an agreement of commitment to this program. We also understand that if our son/daughter decides that he/she does not want to continue in the program, we must wait until the end of the first year at HEC to discuss transfer options.

We understand that HEC students are subject to all applicable policies set forth by Haywood County Schools and Haywood Community College.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Do I have to be an honor student to attend HEC?

No. HEC accepts students from all academic levels; however, students must be committed to honors level coursework.

Can I take any college course that I choose?

No. Students must enroll in classes (according to the academic plan) that count toward a college transfer associate.

Can I participate in athletics?

No. Students are not eligible to compete in athletics at other Haywood County schools.

Can I participate in band, chorus, or ROTC?

No. These activities involve specific high school classes and are not available at HEC.

Can I take driver's education at HEC?

Yes. Classes are available at Pisgah High School and Tuscola High School (depending on student's home district) and students will complete the driving portion at Haywood Early College.

Can I try HEC out for a few weeks and then transfer if I don't like it?

No. There is no trial period. Students must complete their first year before a transfer will be considered.

Do I have to be a car rider if I attend HEC?

No. Bus transportation is provided by Haywood County Schools.

Does it matter in which part of Haywood County I live?

No. HEC represents the geographic diversity of Haywood County.

Does HEC follow the traditional school calendar?

No. HEC has its own calendar that aligns with Haywood Community College. This calendar can be found on the HEC website.

What time does the HEC school day begin and end?

The school day currently begins at 8:30am and ends at 2:20pm.

Are student life opportunities available?

Yes. HEC has several school sponsored clubs and events (fall dance, spring prom). Haywood Community College also welcomes HEC students to participate in campus-wide student events.
