DEDICATED TO OUR STUDENTS

Among the 115 school districts in North Carolina, Haywood County Consolidated Schools ranked 11th based upon the district performance composite for the 2015-16 school year; ranking us in the top 10 percent in the state. This is up from a district ranking of 15th during the 2013-14 and 2014-15 school years.

Since 2013, the state has issued school letter grades to each public school. In 2013-14 Haywood County Consolidated Schools was one of only 8 districts to have no “D” or “F” schools. Since then, Haywood County Consolidated Schools has remained in the elite group of school districts with no “D” or “F” schools. The following chart presents the percentage of schools by letter grade for all North Carolina schools, charter schools and Haywood County Consolidated Schools.

HCS RENEWS ACCREDITATION

After extensive interviews, reviewing a self study, examining student academics, and observing classrooms, the Southern Association of Colleges and Schools (SACS) and AdvancED have renewed Haywood County Consolidated Schools' district accreditation. While visiting the district's schools, the AdvancED review team assessed the quality of teaching and learning in 58 different classrooms. The results rated Haywood County Consolidated Schools measurably higher than the majority of accredited schools in seven key areas: equitable learning, high expectations, supportive learning, active learning, progress monitoring and feedback, well-managed learning, and digital learning. In its final review, the AdvancED team noted two powerful practices of Haywood County Consolidated Schools: a culture that builds on a tradition of high academic performance and a continuous improvement process that models shared leadership resulting in a commitment to student success.



The Haywood County Schools Foundation awarded more than \$187,000 in grant money to teachers, schools, and student activities.

Haywood County Schools Foundation teacher grants are sponsored by Duke Energy, Evergreen Packaging, First Citizens Banks, HomeTrust Bank, and QuickDraw. This year, more than 170 grants funded resources for teachers to enrich the learning experience for their students. Haywood County Schools Foundation also awarded several student activities grants and received grants from ARC.

In April, GE presented Pisgah High School's Career and Technical Education (CTE) program with a \$100,000 grant to support the purchase of new equipment, modernization of curriculum, and training for faculty.

Each teacher grant sponsor has different requirements and focuses of study. The Duke Energy grant provides funds for STEM (science, technology, engineering, and mathematics) projects and programs. Similar to Duke Energy, the Evergreen Packaging grant also promotes math and science. The First Citizens Bank grant provides funding to schools and teachers for reading initiatives. Professional growth and development is the focus of the HomeTrust Bank grant. The QuickDraw art grant provides funds for art teachers to purchase materials for art education.



BMS STUDENTS BUILD PROSTHETIC HAND

Bethel Middle School students used their school's 3D printer to build prosthetic hands for children in need. Last fall, BMS Media Coordinator Kendra Plemmons received a Duke Energy STEM grant through the Haywood County Schools Foundation. She used the grant to purchase a 3D scanner to use in coordination with the school's 3D printer.

As Plemmons researched ways to incorporate the 3D printer and scanner into her curriculum, she found the Prosthetics Kids Hand Challenge.

"The Prosthetic Kids Hands Challenge allows our students the chance to collaborate, design, and print something while also changing the life of a child," Plemmons explained. "For something to

be printed, that means they have spent a great deal of time and patience designing, correcting, and printing their product."

Plemmons said the 3D printer and scanner have given students the opportunity to learn about new technology, from the design software, to the scanner, to the actual 3D printing process, that allows them to interact in real time while using their imagination. Each piece of the prosthetic hand took anywhere from four minutes to several hours to construct, and there are many pieces.

Plemmons shipped the completed 3-D prosthetic hand to Enable the Future, where it was inspected to ensure it functioned properly, and was then sent to a child in need at no cost to their family.

2017 THS SCHOLARSHIP RECIPIENTS

In May 2017 at the Foundation's Partners in Education awards ceremony, 97 high school seniors from Pisgah, Tuscola, Central Haywood, and Haywood Early College received 117 scholarships totaling more than \$177,000. Scholarships ranged from \$300 to \$40,000.

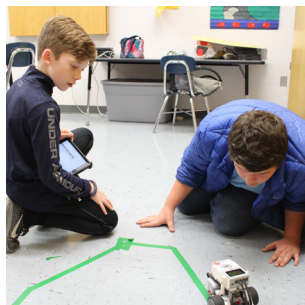
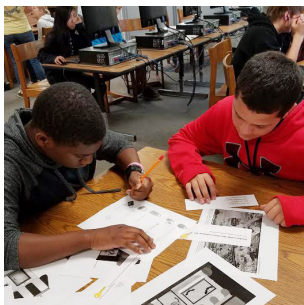
SUGAR PLUM PROJECT

For many children, this is their favorite time of year, as they anticipate Santa's arrival and look forward to receiving new toys and clothing. Unfortunately, many families in our area cannot afford to purchase presents for their children and pay their rent or utility bill. Thanks to generous donations from local businesses and community members, Haywood County Consolidated Schools students in need experienced the joy of the holiday season.

For the past 30 years, the Haywood County Schools Foundation's Sugar Plum Project has provided clothing and gifts to pre-kindergarten, kindergarten, and first grade students in need who are enrolled in Haywood County Consolidated Schools. Most of the children come from low-income families.

DONOR SPOTLIGHT:

DR. DORIS HAMMETT

For more than 60 years, Dr. Doris Hammett has been actively working to improve education for children in Haywood County. Dr. Hammett, a now retired pediatrician, first became involved with Haywood County Consolidated Schools when her oldest daughter began first grade at Hazelwood Elementary in 1958. At the time, Haywood County students entered school in first grade because public kindergarten was not available.

In an effort to assist children who faced difficulties in school, Dr. Hammett, with the

support of the Haywood Medical Society, began a preschool screening program in 1965 at Clyde Elementary School. By 1968, all of Haywood County's elementary schools offered preschool screenings.

The preschool screenings helped identify children who suffered from emotional problems, deprivation, lack of socialization, or physical handicaps including speech, hearing, motor coordination, and visual perceptual defect.

Since then, Dr. Hammett has focused the giving of her time and money to the Science Seminar for capable and interested high school students, Pre-K programs, and Academically or Intellectually

Gifted (AIG) training for teachers. This past school year, her donation was used for staff development. Dr. Hammett says that her volunteer time and monetary donations are one way she is paying it forward.

“Everyone can give something – whether it’s a monetary donation or volunteering in a classroom for a few hours,” she said. “The stock market is going down, so invest in children. You’ll get a better return on investment.”
