- Read with my child and let my child see me read.

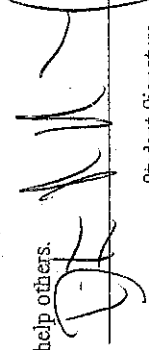

- Maintain a positive attitude, a willingness to learn, share, and help others.

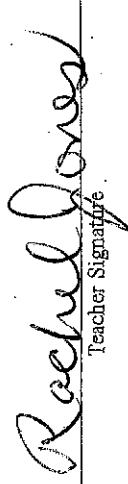

- Check agenda books.

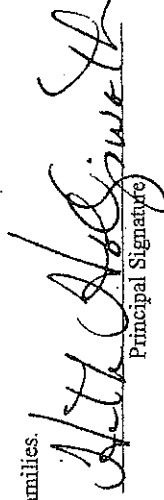
