Learning from Data:

Sally's Fusion Data Questions Considered

Sally shared her Math Fusion data from EVAAS and asked for clarifying questions and thoughts regarding differences in student performance on EOG math tests.

- Does knowing students for a year (or two) make them better placed into Fusion? Conversations regarding upcoming 6th graders that are now happening with BES seem to have given great information that is leading to a better transition.
- How can we personalize and reward the math journey to be similar to our reading journey in a year?
- Does it take students a year to acclimate to Fusion/Sally's methods?
- Did students receive a watered-down curriculum in Fusion as 6th graders?

Does teaming at 6th grade lead to some of the issues with the data? Teaming for the past two years (3rd year in process) has led to gains at the sixth grade level. That was one of the nudges that has led to improvement over the past two years.

Data in Math across the grade span shows that:

- Our Students are growing in the 3 years that they are with us
- We are making strides in our work with 6th graders as a whole
- We need increased vertical collaboration mathematical 4-9 grades
- Any math changes that we make need to be nudges--not sweeping
